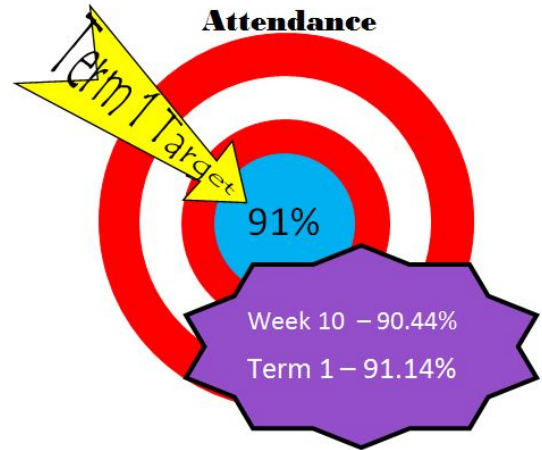


Easter Hat Parade
