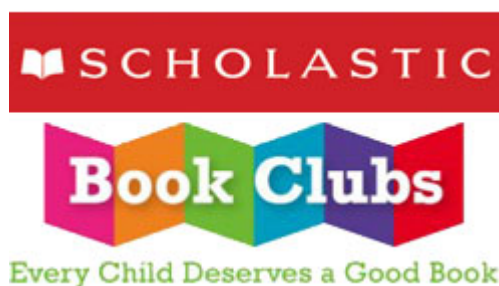

ANZAC Day 2019

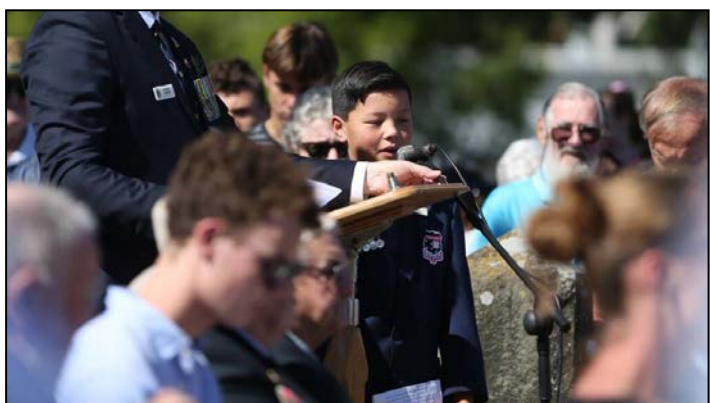
Many thanks to those students and families who proudly took part in the East Maitland RLS Sub-branch's service and march for ANZAC Day last Thursday.
