From the Principal

Welcome to Week 8, only two more to go after this one.

Today our Star Students received their recognition badges in our special assembly. This process is an important part of our PBL (Positive Behaviour Learning) program and students are recognised for always supporting our school's core expectations of Respect, Responsibility and Excellence in all that they do. Being a Star Student means they become eligible for such things as Student Leader opportunities and Leadership roles and responsibilities throughout the school year. Congratulations to our students who received their badges today.

I was extremely proud of those students who undertook the challenge of putting themselves forward for Student Leaders for 2018. Speaking in front of a crowd is always confronting and unsettling and these students undertook this with grace, confidence and good humour. Voting for next year's leaders took place last Friday and a committee of parents and teachers counted the votes today. The successful leaders and their families will be informed of the outcome just prior to our Presentation Day assembly and I know these students will continue to represent our school with pride throughout the following year. A big thank you to Miss McKinnon for her support of the process, for providing our Year 5 students with leadership skills and understanding, and supporting the nominees throughout the process.

Our school has been selected to be a program school for the Shake A Leg initiative for next year. This is a Hunter Health run program for Years 5 and 6 students which is delivered by the Hunter New England Local Health District's Aboriginal Health Unit. The Shake-a-Leg (SAL) program provides all Year 5 and 6 students (both Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal) with age-appropriate health promotion information about healthy eating, physical activity, oral health, drugs and alcohol, bullying, and self-identity. The program is delivered by qualified Aboriginal Health Workers and is fun and interactive.

Students participate in 45 minute sessions, one session per week for a period of six weeks, and this will commence in Term 1 of next year. Students who are currently in Years 4 and 5 received permission notes for this program last week and we'd like them returned by the end of this week if possible please.

This Wednesday is the last session for our 'Almost Kinders'. I've watched these kids go off to their next year's classes with enthusiasm and excitement and I know we'll have a great bunch of kids in our new Kinder classes next year.
