From the Principal

Wow, Week 8 already, where is the year going? I'd like to invite all parents and caregivers to tonight's P&C AGM. Our P&C is a much valued component of our school community, working to ensure our school is a vibrant community which meets the needs of our kids. They provide our families with a canteen and school uniform shop, raise much needed funds for school equipment both for classrooms and the playground, organise events such as the Fun Fair, Carols and special days. 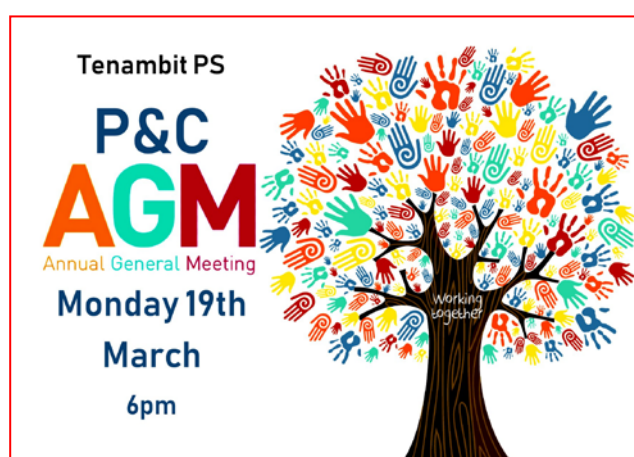

Infants (K-2): 5:00pm - 6:15pm

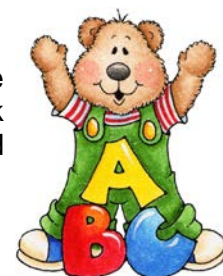
