1/2 Green

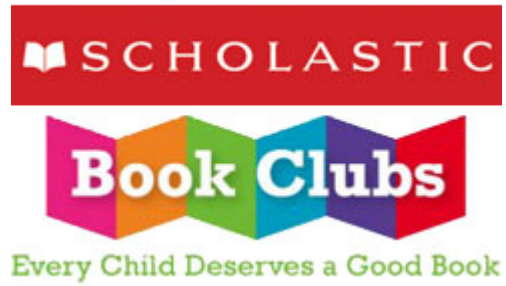

Scholastic Book Club - Reminder

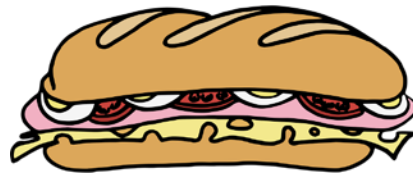
Don't forget to have your book club orders finalised online by this **Wednesday morning, 20th June**.
