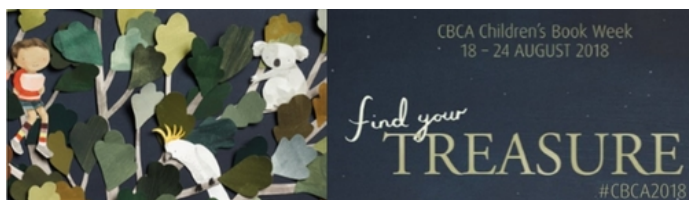


Tenambit Public School P&C Association will be holding a Father's Day Stall on Thursday 30th August 2018.

Can you help out by sending in a gift to be used on the stall? Examples are: mugs, chocolates, pens, socks, beer holders, golf balls and tees, car wash items.

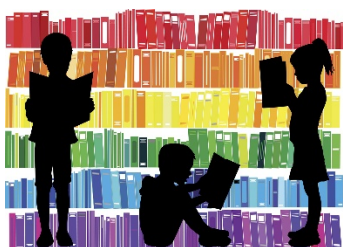
We are also looking for helpers for the stall on the day. If you can assist, please see Ann Cooper or Maree Gilchrist.

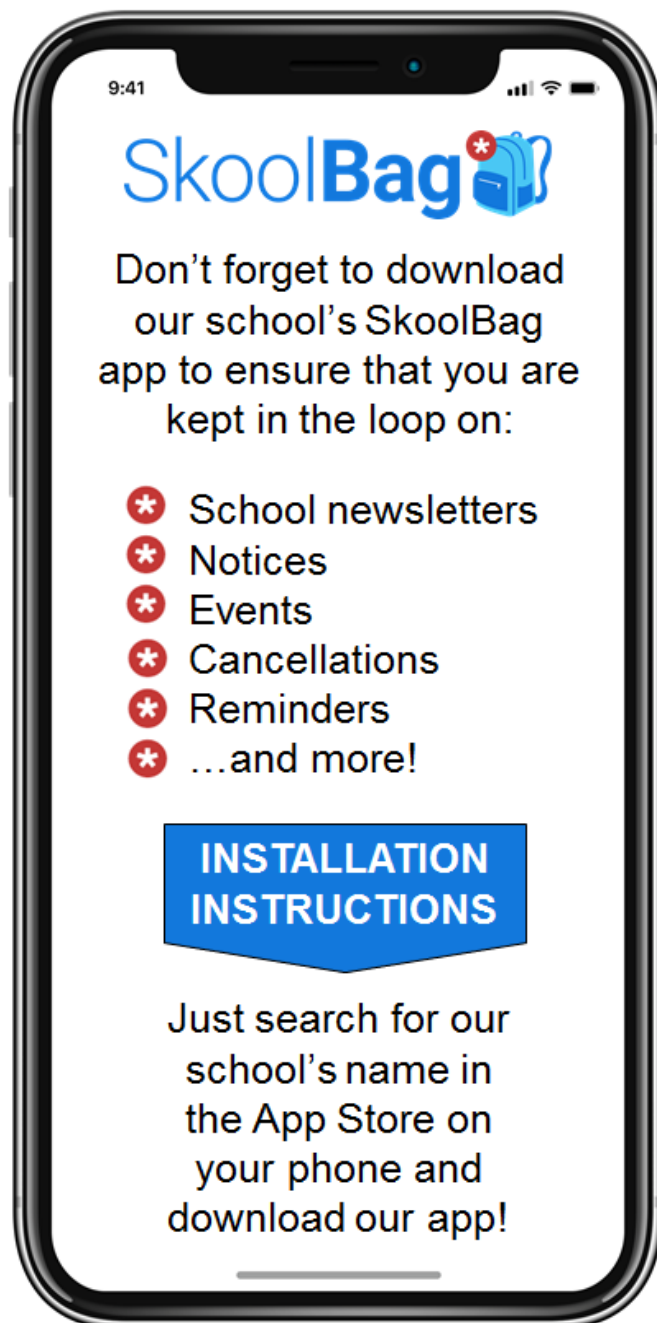
