

7. Select the 'Pay Now' option and enter your billing details. Please include parent's name in this section

- Your card will be charged immediately from order placement.
- Order cut off date is Friday 29th November 2019.
- All orders will be delivered to the school ready for collection on Year 7 Orientation days between 3-6th December.
- Please leave your contact number so we can reach you should we need to regarding your order.
