From the Principal

Wow, it's hard to believe it's Week 10 already. The year has gone by really fast with only eight more school days left after today. We have a busy week ahead with Presentation Day, Year 6 Transition for those students attending Maitland High School, our Year 6 Farewell and our PBL Acknowledgement day for those students who have chosen to spend their three Tenners to attend.

We do hope all of our parents received notification of Tuesday's Teachers Federation industrial action pushed out via Skoolbag last Friday. The majority of our teaching staff will not be attending work on Tuesday and we urge our families to make other arrangements for their children as there will be minimal supervision available at school. Due to this action we have moved all our Presentation Days to Wednesday. As parents are not able to attend in person, we are taking a short video of those children receiving special awards and these videos will be posted on those children's Seesaw accounts for families to view. We will also take a photo and a copy will go home with children on Monday of next week.

Last week we completed the Check In Assessments and we look forward to seeing where our children finished the year. This week we check our network system by doing the NAPLAN online trial. As next year all of our NAPLAN assessment will be online, it's important to check any system errors now and ensure our bandwidth is adequate. I suggest our kids in primary, bring their own set of headphones or earbuds to use if possible.

On Thursday, those students who are attending Maitland High School in 2022, will attend an Orientation Day. Our students will walk to and from the High School, accompanied by Mr Potts and Mr Graham.

Please make sure all permission notes are returned and enrolment forms for the high school have been completed. Our Stage 3 teachers will be busy preparing for Thursday night's Year 6 Farewell on Thursday, ensuring our kids have a great night at what will be their last formal event of Primary School. Our kids always have a great night at the Farewell, spending time with their peers and friends, and their primary school teachers.

And to finish off this week, I'd like to update you on our Permaculture Food Forest. Mr Potts and students have been working with Jesse from Phoenix Park Farm all year and as you can see from Collinson Street, our Food Forest is doing fantastically well. Last week one of our tanks was situated in place with the second one due in over the next couple of weeks. These will help with farming water from our roofs allowing us to water the gardens during restrictions. Our fruit trees are growing, and our fully organic vegetables taste amazing. Mr Potts is adding greenhouses soon, so our children can raise their own seedlings and propagate cuttings for the future. Not only are our kids learning about food sustainability, but maths, science and literacy are all tied into the learning, with a huge dose of wellbeing. If you haven't had a chance to check it out, walk around to Collinson Street.

Flexischools allows you to place all your school orders online in a matter of seconds, at any time of the day.

Download the Flexischools App
 Note: for iPhone and iPad please select 'Allow' notifications.



Click on the search icon, enter your school name, select your school and year group, or groups relevant to you. For new starters to the school – select New Student 2022

Click the 'Order now' button located in the bottom right-hand corner of the app, this will open a login screen.

- Already a Flexischools user Enter your details and login. To save your login details select 'remember me'.
- New Flexischools user Click 'Register', enter your email address and follow the instructions in the email to set up your account. Once your account is set up, add new student, search for our school, enter student details and select their class.
