Over the last few weeks we've been busy getting to know the characters of some entertaining books and working on our goals in Maths. We've also been making the most of the beautiful sunshine we've had lately by having fun experimenting with STEM activities outdoors.

## K-6 Green

K-6 Green have been learning about the Earth's different landscapes, patterns of the Sun, phases of the Moon and all about our Solar System. In Creative Arts we have used this knowledge to depict a view from space and sketched a representation of Neil Armstrong's Moon landing.



K-6 Green have also been observing and documenting the changes to sunrise and sunset times each day for one month as part of our Science & Technology investigation.



## K-6 RED NEWS

In Science this term K-6 Red have been learning about "Earth and Space". Students have especially enjoyed listening to stories with a "space" theme and thought it would be amazing to be an astronaut and travel to the moon in a space shuttle! They had a lot of fun creating an "Outer Space" display to showcase in the classroom. First students decorated astronaut cut outs and glued photos of themselves onto the helmets. Next, they flicked white paint onto black paper to make the background. The moon is made from Styrofoam and the space shuttle was decorated using paint and cellophane.













#### From the Office

If sending cash in with your child to make a payment at the office, please ensure you send the correct money as we do not carry a float.

Our preferred payment option is via our online payment system on our website. Please go to the Tenambit Public School website and click on the blue 'Make a Payment' tab along the top.

Follow the instructions and enter your payment details etc. **Please note, you are not required to enter the student registration number**. Contact the office if you need assistance or have any enquiries. Thank you.

Please note when paying by EFTPOS at the school office, there is a minimum transaction amount of \$10.00 due to fees charged to the school.





Please note if your child commences mediation at school, parents must come into the office to complete an "Administer Medication Form" and must also supply a letter from the Doctor/Paediatrician stating medication dosage and times. Any medication must be supplied in a prescribed Webster packs showing students name and dosage.

If your child requires antibiotics at any time, we still require the "Administer Medication Form" completed and signed by parents prior to giving your child the antibiotics.

This also applies for any Asthma Puffers, form to be completed and puffer to have a prescription label on it.

For students having regular prescribed medication at school, they must bring their own water bottle with them to the office to take their medication. We do not have the facilities to supply cups for students.

#### **Extended Leave – Students**

If you are planning to take your child out of school for a family holiday during the school term, you must contact the school office a week prior to organise completion of a Department of Education Extended Leave Form. This must then be signed by the Principal and a section is given back to you to carry with you during this time.

## <u>REMINDER</u>

A reminder that the administration office hours are 8:30am to 3:15pm.

There are no office staff in the morning until 8:30am, so please ensure you are visiting during the above hours. Just a reminder that Skoolbag has changed to a new platform called Audiri as per below flyer. If you already had the Skoolbag app downloaded this would have transferred over to the new platform automatically. For any new parents/families, follow the instructions below to download the app. This is a great app to have, as when the school has information we need to push out, or do reminders, this is the platform we use, as well as Facebook.

The free Audiri school app offers parents a convenient way to stay up-to-date with the school calendar, last-minute forms, newsletters, all school communications, and even make cashless payments. With Audiri, you can get started in just a few minutes by following these simple steps:

> Open the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store and search for 'Audiri'. Install the app.

Create an account and follow the prompts. Click 'Sign up'. Enter your email address, create a password and click on 'Sign up'. A confirmation email will be sent to confirm your account. Open the confirmation email and confirm your account.

Open the app, and click 'Add/Remove'. Type your school's name and press enter.

Tap the + icon to add. Now you can see your school, under My Schools & Services.


